#### **Original Song Composers Competition Rules:**

- 1. Mele (song) must be about some aspect of Moku Ko'olaupoko the district of Windward O'ahu extending from Kualoa to Waimanalo: something in nature, people, events, history, legends, the spirit of Ko'olau, etc.
- 2. Mele must be an original composition of the applicant listed on this form.
- 3. Mele must not have been previously recorded and/or sold commercially.
- 4. Applicant may enter only one (1) category of the competition.
- 5. Applicant must either perform the composition on-stage for the competition, or must arrange for someone else to perform the new mele at the competition.



- 6. Applicant must agree to allow recording of the mele during the competition for use by the competition sponsors in grant reports or in fundraising for future competitions. All rights to the composition remain with the composer.
- 7. Entry form for the mele composition must be submitted to the Ko`olaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club by <u>Thursday</u>, <u>August 14</u>, <u>2014</u>, <u>4:30 p.m.</u> Forms may be hand-delivered by that date to the civic club office at:
